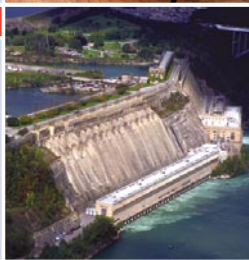

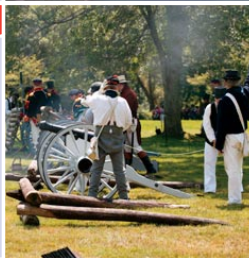
Take a Power Tour at Sir Adam Beck 2 Generating Station and learn about the history of the Niagara River.
