The new Niagara Parks Tree Planting program is part of our commitment to the natural environment and its sustainable development.

Who

Student Groups, with a minimum of 20 to a maximum of 50 paying students per time slot.

What

Students plant deciduous native seedlings known to the Carolinian Life Zone: Parks' staff prepare holes for planting and are on-hand to offer instruction on the benefits of the program, including improved air quality and offsetting the effects of greenhouse gases from automobiles. Each student plants a seedling, filling the hole and mulching the area. Your planting area will be GPS marked to include your School name.

Where

Niagara Parks staff will advise the exact location prior to your group's arrival.

When

Mid-May through June and the day after Labour Day to the Friday before Canadian Thanksgiving Day. 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.; 30-45 minutes (time slots available each ½ hour)

Why

Niagara Parks Tree Planting Program fits the Ontario curriculum (2009) at all grade levels in the Environmental Education: Science and Technology strands.
