





WHAT IS A FLYING THEATRE ATTRACTION?

A flying theatre simulates the experience of free flight, with visitors seated in suspended, gondola-style seating surrounded by a massive domed screen.

High-quality, cinematic video of breathtaking landscapes paired with sensory effects like motion, wind, mist and more create a seamless, immersive experience that makes guests feel as if they are soaring through the sky, just like a bird.

Niagara Takes Flight allows visitors to experience the raw power of Niagara Falls and see its surrounding landscapes across all four seasons. It's an incredible introduction to the destination for first-time visitors, and for those returning, it's an opportunity to see it all from a completely new perspective.

VISITOR EXPERIENCE

Before guests fly, they will journey through four distinct, fully immersive storytelling rooms that unravel Niagara's rich history from geological formation to industrialization and innovation.

Once on board, state-of-the-art drone footage synced with movement and other sensory effects will simulate the exhilarating sensation of flight over areas of Niagara that would be impossible to see any other way.






A FULLY IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE

AUTHENTIC INDIGENOUS STORYTELLING & COMMUNITY COLLABORATION

Authentic storytelling in collaboration with the Indigenous community was essential to the creation of *Niagara Takes Flight*. From ideation to final production, Niagara Parks and Indigenous community leaders worked together to curate authentic narratives about the history of Niagara Falls.

- In preparation for *Niagara Takes Flight*, Niagara Parks supported the establishment of an Indigenous Advisory Panel to guide the attraction's development and design.
- Niagara Parks collaborated with Indigenous artist, Sara General, to incorporate original artwork throughout the experience. Sara is Mohawk, Turtle Clan from Six Nations of the Grand River and draws inspiration from her lived experiences as a Haudenosaunee woman.



The Haudenosaunee Creation Story

Within the Ancestors Room, guests are invited to gather around the fire and learn the story of Turtle Island's creation.

This immersive pre-show room transports guests into an authentic Indigenous storytelling experience, created in collaboration with Indigenous community members.

INVESTING IN NIAGARA'S TOURISM INDUSTRY

Niagara Takes Flight is part of Niagara Parks' ongoing commitment to world-class visitor experiences and supporting tourism growth in Niagara and Ontario. This significant investment of \$25 million, entirely funded by Niagara Parks' earned revenue, is the final stage of the multi-year redevelopment of Table Rock Centre, just steps away from the Horseshoe Falls.
