




Excellence in Environmental StewardshipInitiative (EESI)

In April 2018, the Niagara Parks Commission (NPC) and Brock University's Environmental Sustainability Research Centre (ESRC) developed a partnership called the Excellence in Environmental Stewardship Initiative (EESI). ESRC faculty, staff, and students work in partnership with NPC staff and the community to provide an evidence-based platform for NPC's current and future environmental stewardship practices.









Developing The Environmental Stewardship Plan

We are currently collaborating with NPC staff to develop an **Environmental Stewardship Plan** for the NPC. The Environmental Stewardship Plan follows the directions set out in the NPC Strategic Plan (2018-2028) and will guide actions to enhance environmental stewardship now and in the future.

Accomplishments

While this partnership is still young, it has been remarkably productive. Since it started in April 2018, the partnership has completed the following:

- An inventory of all past Niagara Parks stewardship projects.
- A database for all information involved with this research to allow NPC and partners to make evidence-based decisions for years to come.
- Created a publicly available Google Map of all NPC stewardship projects (scan QR code below).
- Conducted focus group with key NPC individuals to develop future stewardship goals and objectives.
