The original Table Rock building was one of the oldest structures taken over by Niagara Parks in 1886. This venue was a starting point for the Scenic Tunnels, now known as Journey Behind the Falls. In 1926, the old Table Rock House was demolished, and a new Table Rock House was built further south next to the Canadian Horseshoe Falls.

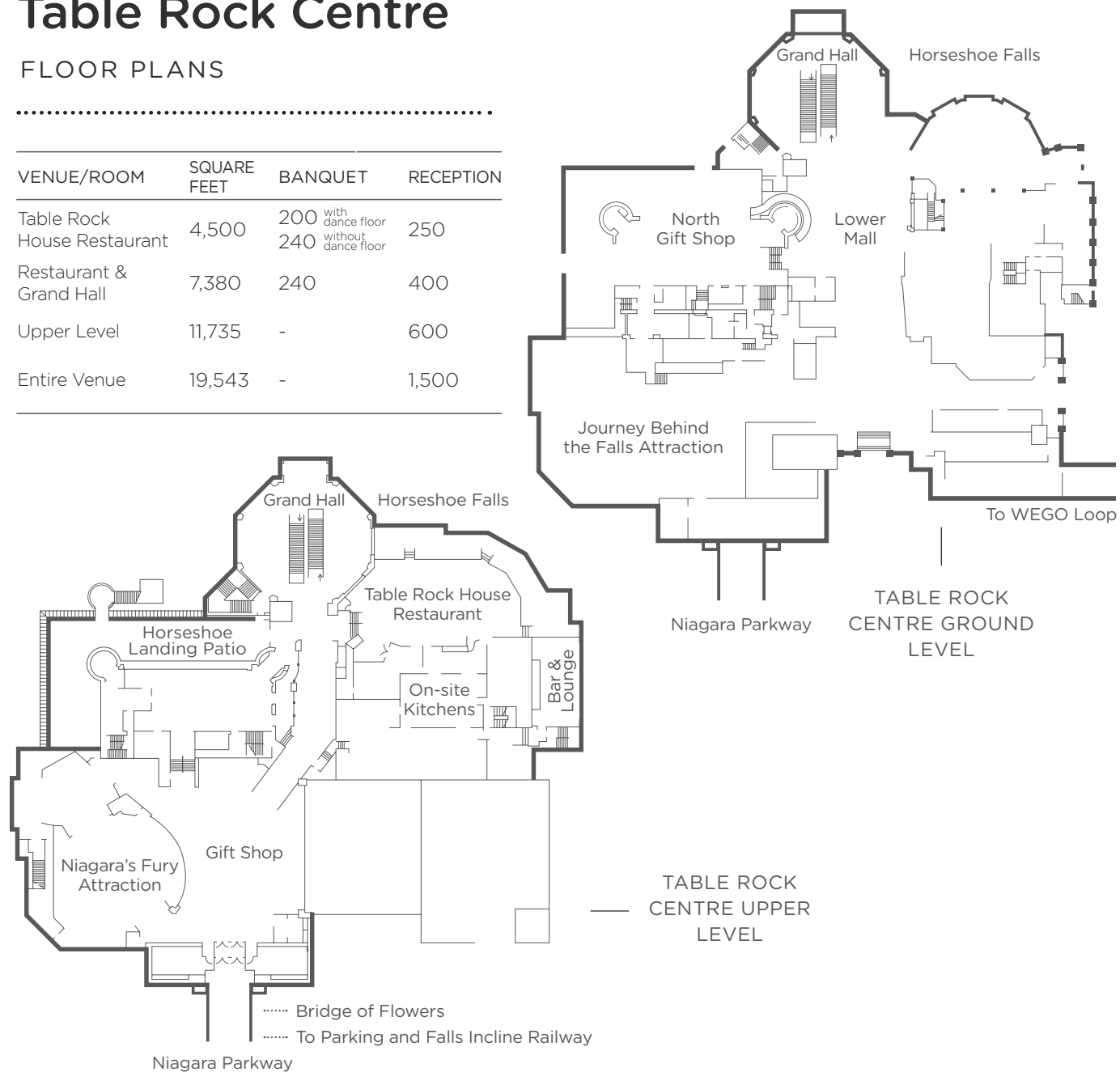

Originally known as the Refectory when built in 1904, this stately building was modeled after a swiss chalet with a distinctive copper roof. Steeped in history, the walls of this fascinating building were formed by 12,000-year-old boulder stones salvaged from bed of the rushing Niagara River.

Capture the magic of the holiday season at the Winter Festival of Lights which features millions of dazzling lights in Queen Victoria Park and throughout Niagara Parks.

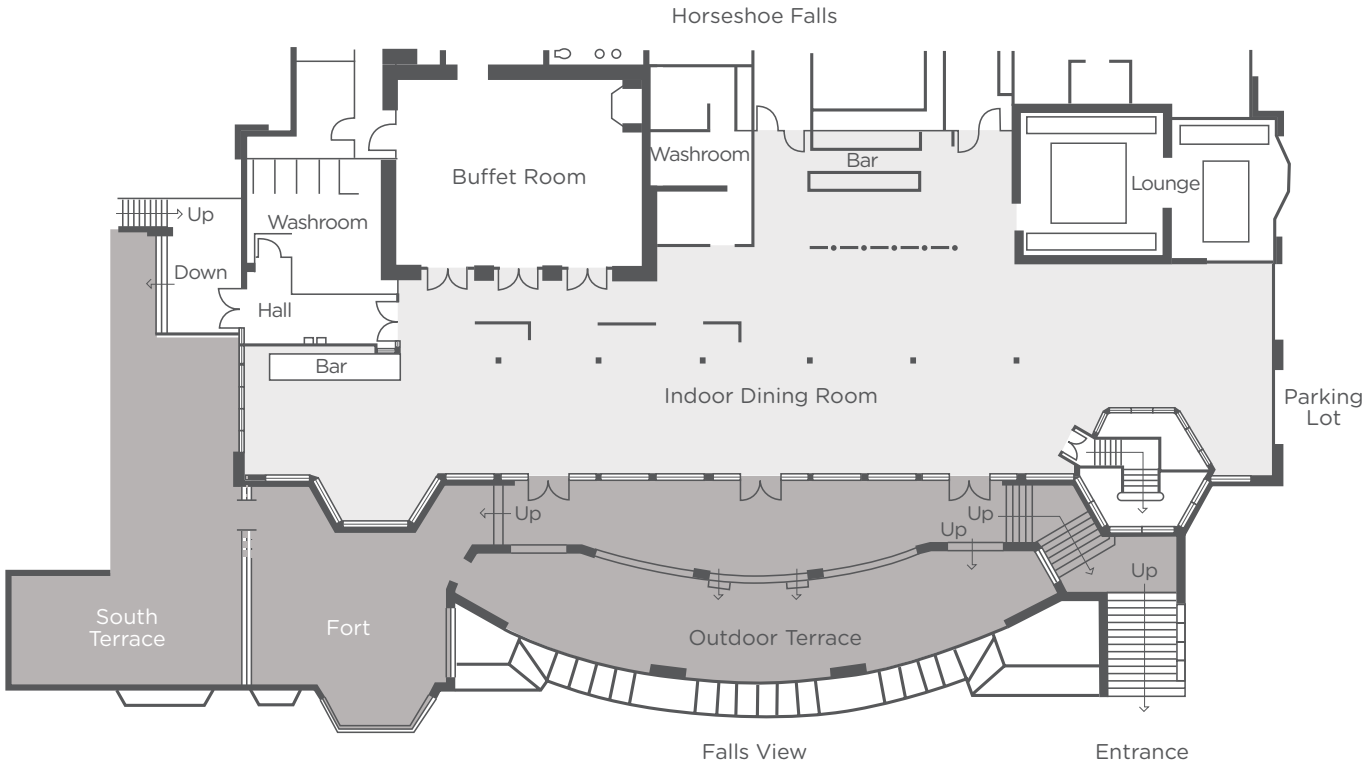

A restaurant was first built in 1900, and the current building with its outdoor patio was built in 1939, using Queenston limestone with a red tile roof.

The expertly maintained Queenston Heights Park offers the absolutely perfect backdrop for your private event.

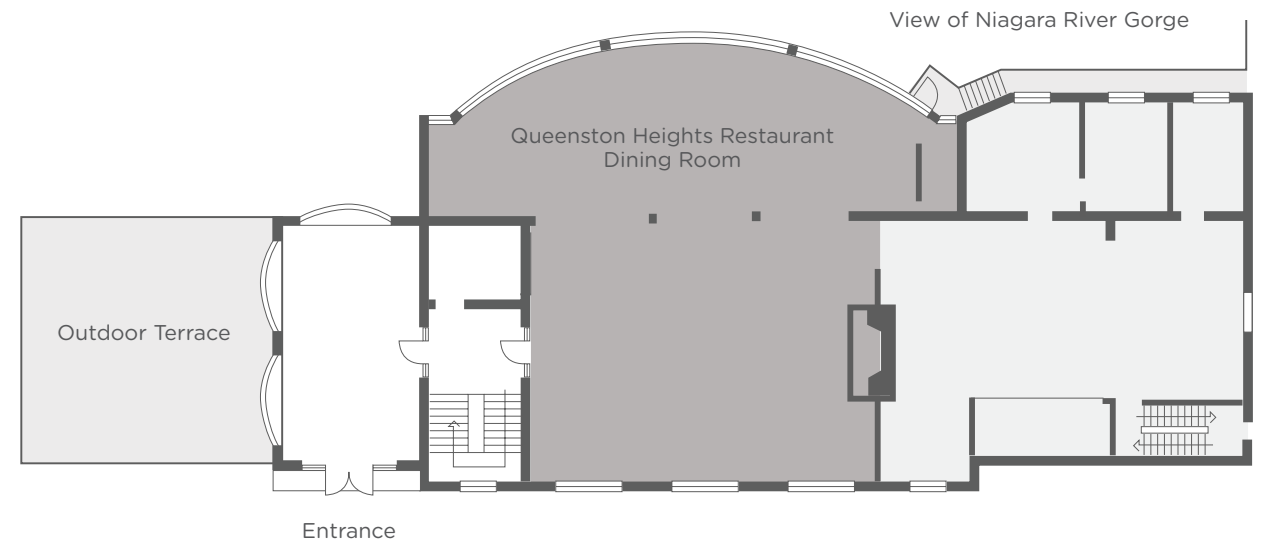

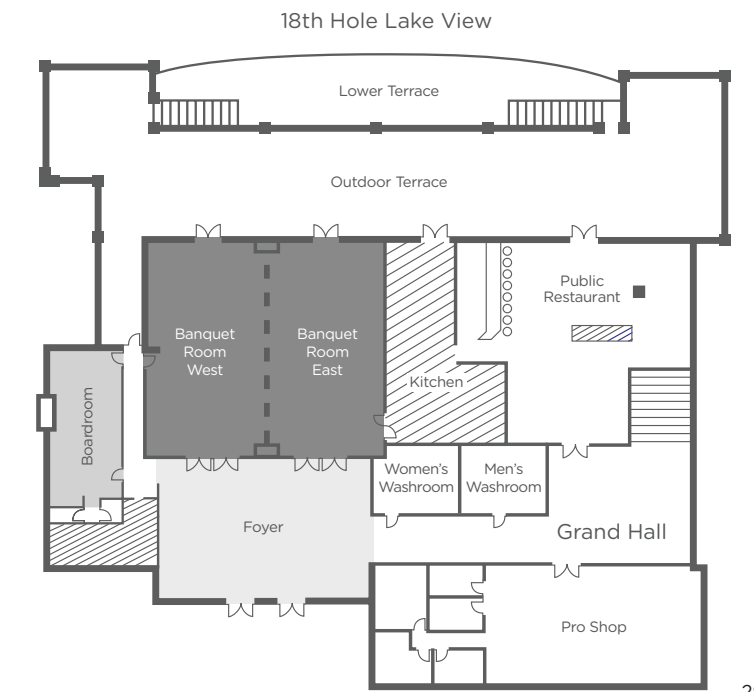
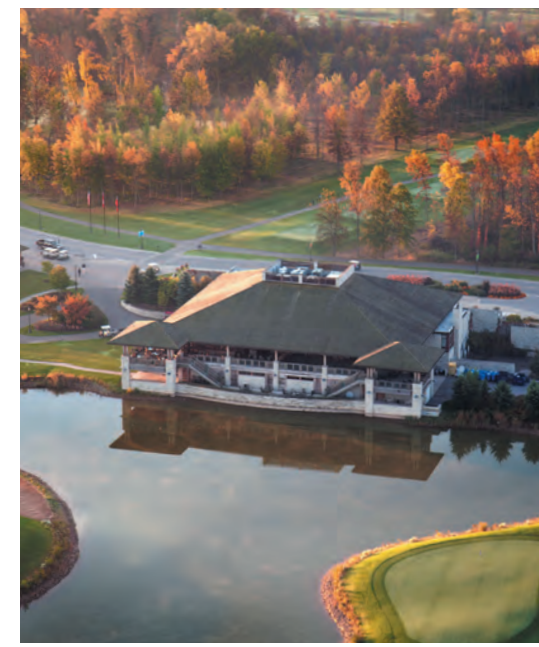

Whirlpool Golf Course

CLUBHOUSE

Designed by famous golf course architect Stanley Thompson, the course officially opened on July 2, 1951, with an international golf tournament between four well-known professionals. Ten thousand spectators witnessed the defeat of the Canadians, Stan Leonard and Bob Gray by the American players, Dr. Cary Middlecoff and Jimmy Demaret. During the first year of operation, the course saw play by some eighteen thousand, two hundred and fifty-one people and by mid-1980 the course had seen its one millionth player.

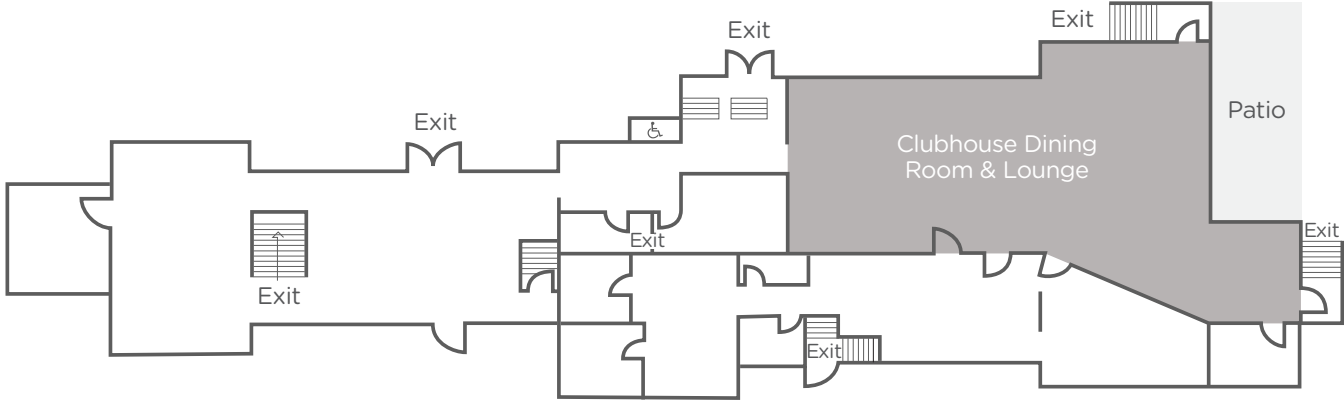

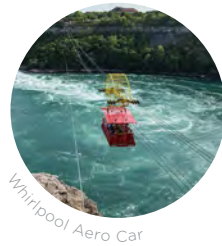
