Your next adventure begins at Niagara Parks.








TABLE ROCK CENTRE


The newly enhanced daytime visitor experience at the *Niagara Parks Power Station + Tunnel* brings history to life in an electrifying way!

NIAGARA TAKES FLIGHT

You may have been here before, but you've never seen Niagara like this.

This new world-class attraction, Niagara Takes Flight opened August 29, 2025 at the brink of Niagara Falls. This must-see attraction features a fully immersive, flying theatre ride takes you soaring along the entire Niagara River corridor, from Lake Ontario to Lake Erie, showcasing views like never before!

Filmed over the span of six months using custom-built drones, Niagara Takes Flight allows guests to experience the exhilarating sights of Niagara from a perspective they simply could not enjoy any other way. With guests suspended in gondola-style seating, the ride simulates flight through state-of-the-art motion programming, sensory effects like wind, mist and even scent, and a spectacular 17-metre-wide dome screen which stretches below their dangling feet. This attraction seamlessly transport guests along the Niagara River corridor with exhilarating stops spanning all-four seasons and transitioning the scenery from day to night.

Before your feet leave the ground, you'll have the opportunity to explore 13,000 years of history through a captivating, media-rich pre-show. This audiovisual experience sets the stage with powerful storytelling that blends geology, culture and time.



BUTTERFLY CONSERVATORY

Step inside one of the largest glass-enclosed butterfly conservatories in North America and discover a tropical garden oasis. The *Niagara Parks Butterfly Conservatory* is home to over 2,000 vibrantly coloured butterflies, who flutter freely along winding pathways surrounded by lush vegetation and trickling waterfalls.

Stroll through 180 metres of meandering paths lined with towering tropical plants and gorgeous blooms. Along the way, you'll find feeding trays for an up-close look at these delicate creatures, the specially selected flowers that attract them and a picturesque waterfall that helps recreate the magic of the rainforest here in Niagara.


WHIRLPOOL AERO CAR

Hop on the historic *Whirlpool Aero Car* for an unforgettable ride over the vibrant, teal-coloured waters of the Niagara River.

Built in 1916, this visitor favourite lets you soar 3,500 feet across the Niagara Gorge and take in spectacular views of the swirling Niagara Whirlpool and the river's powerful Class 6 rapids.

Feel the thrill of standing at the river's edge!

White Water Walk offers a first-hand lesson in the raw power and peril of the Niagara River's Class 6 whitewater rapids, some of the wildest in North America. The roar of the river provides a deceptively tranquil tone as you stroll along a quarter-mile boardwalk, with viewing platforms that bring you incredibly close to the action.

This self-guided experience also shares fascinating stories about the geology of the Niagara Gorge, as well as the plant and animal life you may encounter during your visit to Niagara Parks.







NIAGARA PARKS GOLF

LEGENDS ON THE NIAGARA

The Legends on the Niagara facility is Canada's premier public golf destination. The grounds feature two championship courses, a par-3 executive course, a 360° driving range spread over 45 acres, a world-class training facility and a spectacular clubhouse restaurant.

Battlefield: Located on the north side, the imposing Battlefield course was designed by golf architect Douglas Carrick. It offers unique challenges suitable for all skill-levels.

Ussher's Creek: One of golf architect Thomas McBroom's finest masterpieces, this challenging and breathtaking course features heavily wooded tree lines, wetland hazards, knee-high fescue rough, and impeccable conditioning from tee to green. These elements combine to make Ussher's Creek a classic parkland course.

Chippawa Executive Course: The Chippawa executive course perfectly complements the larger Battlefield and Ussher's Creek courses. Each hole presents a new challenge. You'll have trouble making par if you miss the green from the tee.
