

Gliding over swirling rapids and steep rock faces, past lush forests and through dramatic battles that changed the course of history, before getting closer than ever to the thundering Horseshoe Falls.

ONTARIO'S FIRST FLYING THEATRE

Thanks to cutting-edge technology and breathtaking aerial drone cinematography, visitors can see Niagara Falls through the eyes of a bird.

Cinematic footage captured year-round unfolds on a massive 17-metre (55 ft.) domed screen inside a state-of-the-art theatre. Motion-based seating and other sensory effects like wind, mist and scent come together to engage the senses and enhance the exhilarating illusion of free flight while guests soar through all four seasons.

It's an incredible introduction to the destination for firsttime visitors, and for those returning, it's an opportunity to see it all from a completely new perspective.

It takes visitors on a wonderful aerial roller coaster ride, showcasing a variety of hidden natural wonders that would be impossible to see any other way.

THE ANCESTORS ROOM

Inside the Ancestors room, created in deep collaboration with members of Niagara's Indigenous communities, visitors are invited to gather 'round the fire as elders share stories passed down over millennia. This vibrant space was brought to life with stunning original artwork by Indigenous artist Sara General.

Sara General is Mohawk, Turtle Clan from Six Nations of the Grand River where she lives with her husband, three children, and pet turtle. Sara is a writer, artist, language learner, and researcher, and she holds a Doctor of Education from Western University. In addition to her work for Spirit & Intent, an Indigenous publishing company she co-founded to make language books for her community, Sara's work has been published by Rubicon Books, Kayak Magazine, Exile Quarterly, Theytus Books, and Hamilton Arts & Letters.
