Niagara Parks operates as a self-financed entity under the Ontario Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Gaming.


Our primary objective is to protect the natural and cultural heritage along the 56 km Niagara River corridor, which traverses from Lake Erie to Lake Ontario. This includes the protection of distinctive natural features such as the Niagara Glen, Niagara River Gorge and, notably, the iconic Canadian Horseshoe Falls. Since our establishment in 1885, Niagara Parks has diligently worked towards protecting the delicate habitats and at-risk species within the corridor, while also preserving the sense of adventure and awe that render Niagara a global symbol.

Niagara Parks is actively investing its resources, capital, dedication and innovation into the preservation and rehabilitation of the most delicate and cherished land and aquatic habitats within the Niagara River corridor. Additionally, we are committed to safeguarding the native flora and fauna of our distinctive region, while simultaneously combatting invasive species that pose a threat.

We are not alone in these efforts. We collaborate with a diverse array of partners spanning government, research, education, business and our local community to spearhead impactful conservation initiatives. However, our foremost collaborator is you—the businesses operating in Niagara, along with community leaders and stakeholders. The collective residents, visiting enterprises and community influencers are central to the environmental stewardship mission of Niagara Parks. 






Queen Victoria Place






Queen Victoria Place Restaurant




Queenston Heights Restaurant

GOLF COMPLEX

This golf facility opened the summer of 2001 with two 18-hole championship courses, one 9-hole course, as well as a 360-degree circular driving range. Adjacent to the historic Battle of Chippawa site, this War of 1812-inspired venue is an unprecedented setting with natural and cultural heritage at its very core.

The first of its kind in Canada, this magnificent golf complex features two unrivaled 18-hole championship courses. The complex also features a 9-hole executive short course, a 45-acre, 360° driving range, and the Legends Golf Academy, all less than 15 minutes from the Falls. Designed by renowned architects Douglas Carrick and Thomas McBroom, these Audubon-certified golf courses take full advantage of a supremely natural site.

Legends is ideal for your off-site dining or tournament event with an unparalleled play experience and full service banquet options at the spectacular Legends Clubhouse.







Niagara Parks Power Station

+ TUNNEL

Step into the past as you immerse yourself in the rich history of the station's Generator Floor, brought to life through captivating exhibits, meticulously restored artifacts, and engaging, interactive narratives. This impressive space, referred to as the Cathedral of Power, can accommodate up to 800 guests.

Then, descend 180 feet via a glass-enclosed elevator that will bring guests down to The Tunnel. Venture through the original 2,200-foot-long tailrace tunnel and step out onto a brand-new viewing platform and enjoy an entirely new vantage point with panoramic views of Niagara Falls.

Power Station at Night:

Experience a different perspective of Niagara's cathedral of power after dark with an all-new nighttime experience.

Offering unprecedented access to the Niagara Parks Power Station + Tunnel, this nighttime adventure will take you deeper into Niagara's story of power with never-before-shared details of the power station's phenomenal history, including newly unveiled multimedia storytelling and flexible screenings of Currents, an epic sound and light show.

In the Tunnel, encounter one of the world's most legendary natural wonders from an observation platform at the edge of the Niagara River – the illuminated Horseshoe Falls await!













Whirlpool Pub + Lounge
